



Shoreland's recommendation: Vaccination is recommended for all travelers over 9 months of age, except vaccination is not recommended for those whose itineraries are clearly restricted to Khartoum. Note: entry requirements may apply.

CDC recommendation: Vaccination is recommended for all travelers > 9 months of age (arriving from any country).

WHO recommendation: WHO does not make country-specific yellow fever recommendations but does make a general recommendation of vaccination for travel outside the urban areas of countries in the endemic zone. Sudan is yellow fever endemic according to WHO criteria.

Officially infected areas (according to WHO): Territory south of 12 degrees N.
